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REPORT ON

2ND CONGRESS OF THE INTERNATIONAL PHOTO THERAPY ASSOCIATION - IPTA

QUEENSTOWN, NEW ZEALAND, 25-27 APRIL, 2008

The congress was an excellent opportunity for exchange of knowledge among scientists from different disciplines:e.g. physicians, physics, engineers, biologist, physical therapist and more.

Friends from Australia, Asia, Europe and America gathered in this angle of paradise and discussed the action mechanisms of laser and light effects on the human body, with particular emphasis on non- surgical laser effects.

Prof. G.D. Baxter and his staff, perfectly organized the meeting, including social programs.

The state-of-the-art, of non surgical laser effects, on muscle-skeletal pain, skin ulcers, spinal cord injuries, cerebral palsy and diabetes, were shown and discussed. A final workshop in presence of all speakers helped clarifying some doubt.

The Executive Committee Assembly of the IPTA made the following decisions

- 1 Date and place of next Congress: **November 2009, 6-8, in Firenze, Italy,** jointed with **Laser Florence 2009**, IALMS annual congress.
- 2 Next President of the IPTA: after Prof. Y. Asagai, immediate past-president, Prof. G.D. Baxter, until November 2009, then Prof. L. Longo. actual general secretary.
- 3 Laser Therapy journal remains the official journal of IPTA.

The Editorial Board renewed, including excellent Scientists, dedicated to research on the effects of laser and light on human body and cooperating with IPTA.

4 – The IPTA Website will be on air soon, with a restricted(by password) members area.



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Cooperation agreement

The IALMS signed a new agreement for a bilateral cooperation and promotion of common goals and interests, with the New European Surgical Academy- NESA, held in Karower Str. 1/214 13125 Berlin. You can see below the text of our cooperation agreement.

Preliminary note:

The International Academy of Laser Medicine and Surgery (IALMS) is a non-profit organization.

The prior aim of the New European Surgical Academy (NESA) is to optimise existing surgical procedures and to initiate and / or introduce new procedures and innovations in surgery, both on national and international level. Evaluation of the proposed procedures will be made by conducting prospective studies, which will thereafter be published in order to contribute to the medical progress. NESA will initiate European consensus documents in the disciplines presented (ob /gyn, general surgery, urology, otolaryngology and anaesthesiology).

Both associations decided, due to their similar purposes, to sign the following cooperation agreement:

I. Aims of the cooperation

- (1) The aim of the cooperation takes into account the principles and special conditions of both associations in order to achieve the best possible results by cooperation.
- (2) Definition of the common aims:
 - a) Analysing and optimising surgical procedures, also from the point of view of an appropriate clinical use of blood.
 - b) Beyond the optimisation of surgical processes, new ideas for surgical procedures -and transfusion alternativeswill be examined, evaluated and introduced for the benefit of the patients.
 - c) As interdisciplinarity is an important part of the cooperation, both sides agree to promote the interdisciplinarity and to implicate other medical disciplines in the common dialogue.
 - d) Helping international, European and national Scientific Societies to conceive that "Transfusing medical science into medical practice", also in the field of Transfusion Medicine, is the real present challenge all over Europe.
- (3) Further cooperation with other internal and foreign partners is reserved to both sides according to their own activities, statutes and obligations.



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II. Mutual support

To achieve the aims defined in paragraph I, both sides will support each other as follows:

- (1) NESA will submit proposals to realise one or more of the aims defined in paragraph I, which NESA considers to be necessary for analysis and evaluation in prospective studies. If the IALMS accepts these proposals, the IALMS will provide adequate contacts for caring about the educational aspects of these studies and support these projects.
- (2) In a similar way the IALMS will be entitled to forward proposals for one or more of the aims defined in paragraph I to NESA. If NESA accepts these proposals, NESA will help in the implementation of these proposals.
- (3) The exchange of ideas, and of professional and educational know-how in the medical, social or juristic field, is formally agreed.
- (4) Mutual providing with existing contacts and connections if and when requested.
- (5) The transfer of data, according to item 4, has to take place by ensuring the legal regulations of both sides.

III. Organisation of the cooperation

- (1) The presidents of both sides will be responsible for the constant dialogue to discuss upcoming programs or consensus documents.
- (2) If necessary, both presidents will select competent partners and involve them concerning scientific and educational questions and recommendations.
- (3) The partners of this agreement intend to make the results of their common work public. The intellectual rights concerning the results and the right for publication belong to both sides likewise. Medical recommendations, which are a result of this cooperation, and information about common projects may be published only after agreement of both sides.
- (4) The details of ways of cooperation in specific projects will be specified for each project.
- (5) Towards third-parties the partners are acting on their own behalf, unless there are agreements for specified projects as mentioned in paragraph 4.

IV. Expenses and financing

- (1) Both sides bear their own expenses, which are the result from their common activities. A reimbursement from both sides is excluded unless agreed in advance.
- (2) In case that expenses occur by a third-party, the partners will set up an agreement to finance these expenses, before the order is placed to the third-party.



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V. Validity period of this agreement

- (1) The agreement will be signed for an indefinite period.
- (2) Both sides can terminate this agreement under observance of a time limit of three months to the end of month. In this case, an arrangement about the proceeding with current projects will be made.
- (3) The right of extraordinary cancellation remains unaffected by this regulation.

VI. Severability clause

Modifications or amendments must be in written form to be of validity. If this agreement does not regulate all related facts, legal regulations will be taken into account. In case, that some particular regulations have or will have no legal standing, the validity of the other regulations will not be affected. This ineffective regulation has to be interpreted, if possible, in such a way, that the aimed financial aspects can be achieved.

Signed in June, 2008

This agreement follows a similar one between NESA – ISLSM (the International Society for Laser in Surgery and Medicine)
Members who wish to join NESA (free of charge) can do so by sending their CV + Photo, either to Prof Longo (President IALMS) or Prof Baruchin (President ISLSM).
